

Fire Union Suppression Payoffs

- Sick Leave
 - Maximum payoff is 75% of your sick leave balance
 - Total payoff = ((Sick Leave Balance x 65%) + Leave Payoff % calc. (See Below)) x hourly rate
- Annual Leave
 - This is paid one to one
 - Total Payoff = Annual Leave Balance x Hourly Rate
- Comp
 - This is paid one to one
 - Total Payoff = Comp Leave Balance x Hourly Rate

Example

John Smith – Hourly Rate - \$23.14

Sick Leave Bank Balance – 3,000 (h)

Sick Leave Payoff % - 2

Annual Leave Bank Balance – 336.15 (h)

Comp Bank Balance – 50 (h)

Calculation

Sick

3000 (h) x 65% = 1,950 (h)
Total = 1,950 (h)

Sick Leave Payoff %

2 / .25 = 8
3,000 (h) x 8 x .0025 = 60

Total Sick

Total Sick Hours = 1,950 (h) + 60 (h) = 2,010 (h)
Sick Payoff = 2,010 (h) x \$23.14 = **\$46,511.40**

Annual

336.15 (h) / 1 = 336.15 (h)
Total = 336.15 (h)
Annual Payoff = 336.15 (h) x \$23.14 = **\$7,778.51**

Comp

50 (h) / 1 = 50 (h)
Total = 50 (h)
Comp Payoff = 50 (h) x \$23.14 = **\$1,157.00**

Total Payoff = \$46,511.40 + \$7,778.51 + \$1,157.00 = \$55,446.91
